Starjump Clubs are for **Visual Spatial Learning** kids who feel like "fish out of water" at school, academically and/or socially.

With all the challenges and frustrations that these kids have to go through every day, it is extremely important that these kids get to socialize with like minds. Making friends will also become easy.

At the Starjump Club, they can be themselves because their differences will be understood and appreciated.

Starjump Club's aim is to provide a space where the kids are challenged in the areas of their cognitive strengths. It is a place for them to be creative thinkers with other kids who are just like them so that they can discover themselves and shine.

All students participating in the Starjump Program are automatically enrolled into the club and will be invited to join in the activities organized once 2 or more kids of same caliber or complimentary skill sets are identified.

In Malaysia, the Starjump Club activities were held for 3 groups of kids during the 2-week June school holidays.

As the kids in all of the 3 groups were meeting each other for the first time, the topic activity chosen was focused on Social & Interaction Skills.

Various games and activities that took place during the 1 ½ - 2 hour session focused on helping/guiding the kids on:

- how to work in a team
- respecting yourself and others
- introversion
